SECTION 10

Regional Stamps

(Questa and Waddington)

In 1981 the contracts for printing regional stamps passed from Harrisons and were awarded to Questa (for Northern Ireland and Wales) and to Waddingtons (for Scotland). Both produced these stamps by lithography and not photogravure. As from April 1986 the Waddington work has been transferred to Questa.

Types and Settings. The Machin head has appeared in various types, but we do not list them because a given value does not exhibit more than one type. As with the national Machin series, identification is by paper and gum, plus (for Questa printings) the change in perforation from 13½ x 14 to 15 x 14 and later to 15 x 14 (E1). Value types and settings have undergone modification with values redrawn in the narrower, more modern style mentioned in Section 3. The 22p Scotland is an example, with the narrower value tablet introduced at the change of colour. In this case, too, the Queen's head is slimmer and smaller with differences in the lower folds of the hair at the back.

Redrawn Emblems. B. Alan Ltd. were the first to publicise, in the autumn of 1985, that a regional emblem had been redrawn. This was the Scottish lion and it was soon apparent that the Wales and Northern Ireland emblems also existed in more than one type. The explanation for redrawing, published by Jeffery Matthews in May 1986, was the change from photogravure to lithographic printing. Each regional emblem occurs in two versions in the lithographed stamps, details of which are given below with the respective lists. The printers were at first working erroneously from artwork prepared in 1976 for presentation packs. The correct artwork for lithography, drawn in 1981-82, was introduced piecemeal from 1983 onwards. Although the lithographic emblems are thus given numbered types 1 and 2, the earlier photogravure versions (Section 9) are not numbered into the sequence.

Two-colour printing. A change to two-colour printing for first-class regionals (then 17p) occurred when Questa took over the Scotland range and the stamp was issued on 29 April 1986. The change followed the Post Office's request to achieve a result closer to the colour standard. In July 1986 Questa began printing the Northern Ireland and Wales 17p also in two colours, but these had no particular first day of issue.

Though most lithographed regionals look monocoloured, they are not necessarily produced from a single plate. When used, two-colour printing improves the solid appearance of the stamp. Waddington mostly printed the head from one plate and the background from another. Questa favours printing a full image and the two plates can vary slightly in colour: this is easily visible in the marginal plate numbers.

Single-plate printing in lithography is normally screened. In two-plate printing the background may be solid and the head screened.

Paper and gum. Details of papers and gums are given in the General Introductory Notes, but additionally in the regionals some paper was supplied by the Inveresk Paper Co. It is deficient in optical brightening agent; what is actually FCP/PVA (low OBA) was hitherto classified as OCP/PVA.

Only Harrison's PVA gum is tinted (yellowish); that from other papermakers is not. Harrison's DEX gum has a bluish green tinge; Slater's has no tint but is sometimes a little yellower than the PVA for which it could be mistaken.

The very thick paper of Waddington's 13p Scotland with Type 1 Lion(CC LS131) was on FCP/PVA with an experimental coating. It is low in optical brightener, giving a dull ultra-violet reaction.

Phosphor screen. Waddington phosphor bands are typographed and Questa bands appear to be lithographed. As such, neither type shows a screen. Bands have only been applied to the values for second-class mail and those used in booklets, the rest being on phosphor coated paper.

Side bars. Another Questa innovation of 29 April 1986 occurred with the Scotland 12p FCP/DEX (CC LS121). Side bars of phosphor were introduced, interrupted bands keeping the area between stamps clear of phosphor to aid the perforating operation. It was extended to the 12p and 13p stamps of all three regions.

Centre bars. The new-rate 14p regionals in October 1988 saw centre bars introduced. They are interrupted phosphor bands, 4.5mm in width, but deliberately placed to the right of centre (OR).

Plate numbers. See Section 16 for plate numbers.

As with some other published schemes, the classification of this difficult symbol in the 8th edition was not completely satisfactory and has since been revised.

The new method of identifying symbols corresponds to an apparent sequence of events where the incorrect Type 1 drawing, meant for photogravure, was abandoned after the 12½p printing in July 1984. Values from 23.10.84, and subsequently, make use of the strengthened images available in the drawing prepared specifically for offset-litho (Type 2).

However, over the years the printer has introduced flaws in printing from Jeffery Matthews's new artwork, notably the joined pearls. As the flaws are constant they merit recognition as sub-types 2a and 2b. The 15p (LN150), 19p (LN190) and 22p (LN222) of 1988-90 seemingly reintroduced a thin thumb line and thin arch. It is improbable that the pre-1984 Type 1 drawing is back in use: more likely they remain Type 2's, the thinner lines coming from faulty register of the second colour.

Unlike the Scotland and Wales lithographed regionals, it is often easier to separate different printings of a given Northern Ireland value by factors other than the symbol type. The earlier use of heavy screening is a particular hindrance, making it impossible to distinguish joined from separate pearls, for example. In looking at individual values helpful pointers can thus be: changes of colour and perforation; whether phosphor bands or bars; and differing gums DEX or PVA. The screening becomes helpful for the 28p and 31p if distinguishing PCP and ACP papers is found troublesome. The change from dark to light in the gradated background occurs at quite different places.
